Attractions All Around Us

See the wonders of our Southwest playground; from our unique & colorful desert flowers and red rock formations, to starlit skies and massive canyons, to ancient saguaros and snow-covered mountains.

Sabino Canyon:

Just minutes from our resort, explore desert trails for all skill levels. With trails from .8 miles to 10.1 miles, there's something for all, including a guided tour on wheels. We offer shuttle service to this convenient, special and wildly popular destination.

Arizona Sonoran Desert Museum:

A world-renowned zoo, natural history museum and botanical garden in one, the Arizona Sonoran Desert Museum is home to mountain lions, Gila monsters, prairie dogs—and a variety of cacti and indigenous minerals.

Tucson Botanical Gardens:

Designated America's Best Secret Garden by Reader's Digest, this 5+ acre collection of 17 specialty gardens is hidden in the heart of the city.

Mt. Lemmon Sky Center:

Within 45 minutes of our resort, drive or cycle up the 25 mile steep Catalina Highway and arrive at over 9,000 feet in elevation, and discover lush green 'sky islands' with brilliant evergreens. At Mt. Lemmon Sky Center, tour the large scale research telescope; or enjoy a yummy piece of pie at the famous Mt. Lemmon Café in Summerhaven. Ride the ski lift up to Ski Valley for a view of winter snow or blooming wildflowers!

Biosphere 2:

With a unique history, Biosphere 2 is 7.2 million cubic foot sealed glass structure with 6,500 windows residing on 40-acres of campus that's now a center for research, outreach, teaching and lifelong learning about the Earth, living systems and the universe.

Mission San Xavier del Bac:

Acclaimed as the finest example of mission architecture in the US southwest of Tucson, lavish 214-year old structure is on the Tohono O'odham Reservation. Free guided tours explain the Mission's special history and ornate design.

Pima Air & Space Museum:

From the alien surface of Mars and the vast reaches of space to its modern beginnings in the Wright Brothers' triumph of flight, over 100 years of Aerospace history and 300 aircraft are displayed on 80 acres of desert.

Tohono Chul Park:

Themed gardens, nature trails, eclectic shops, art galleries, classes, wildlife and a charming Tea Room serving delicious delicacies. Named one of the great botanical gardens of the world by Travel + Leisure.

Kartchner Caverns:

This stunning 'live' limestone cave offers unique mineral formations, where stalactites drip down like icicles and stalagmites rise up like giant trees. Guided tours explain this natural phenomenon at one of Southern Arizona's most prized state parks.
